Getting started with your OpenAthens account

To access subscription-based material (databases, journals, etc.) at the IIRP Graduate School Library, you will need an OpenAthens (OA) account. This will authenticate you as a library user and allow you to access these materials without restrictions.

An OA account will be created for you. Once created, you will need to activate it to be able to access subscribed content.

Step 1. You will receive an email notifying you that you are eligible to create an OA account:
